

YOU SHOULD ALWAYS USE A SIZING KIT. When not available, the following procedure should be followed.

MAKING SURE IT ALWAYS FITS

In order to ensure the best possible fit, avoid errors in sizing and unnecessary costly mistakes; we have put together for you several useful tools. **Following the measuring instructions carefully and having firefighter and sales personal sign the required documents will greatly reduce the risk of ordering a suit that will not fit properly.**

We would like to remind you that when a suit does not fit properly and that it was built according to the measurements that you have provided. It is your responsibility to pay for the required alterations or suit replacement. In the event that INNOTEX® made a mistake, we will fix or replace the suit at our expense.

We suggest two methods for measuring firefighters accurately:

Method # 1: Using a sizing kit

Please follow instructions in procedure titled “**Measuring process with sizing kits**” and write the appropriate sizes and adjustments in the configurator through the Dealer Zone “Sizing and Personalization” section or on form M-214 Measuring Form - Sizing Kit.



Method # 2: **Regular measuring procedure**

Please follow **photo illustrations** titled “**How to measure**” and write the appropriate measurements in the configurator through the Dealer Zone “Sizing and Personalization” section or on form M-209 Measuring Form - Tape.
